Fieldtrip organised by Geologica Belgica at the occasion of the 2019 E. Van den Broeck medal awarded to the *Cartographes de la Région wallonne*

Venue: 9h00 at Malmedy, parking Moviemills (50°25'52"N, 6°01'42"E)
As we are nearly 50 people, we will group people to have a minimum of cars.

Guide: cartographers of the Walloon Region

1. Warche quarry (Nelles company) at Mont-Xhoffraix (50°26'48"N, 6°03'11"E)
Unconformity between Ordovician and Permian rocks.
2. Walk: outcrop along a path (50°27'00"N, 6°05'38"E)
Unconformity between Ordovician and Devonian rocks.

Lunch time: Robertville, "Chez Phil" (50°27'16"N, 6°07'20"E)
Drinks and soup are available at the cafeteria but **the participants have to bring their own picnic.**

Ceremony for the "Cartographes de la Région wallonne".

The Van den Broeck medal of the scientific association Geologica Belgica is awarded to a person with great merits for the advancement of geosciences in Belgium. This year's laureate is the team of the geologists who have mapped the Walloon Region for nearly 30 years. As they are completing the field surveys, Geologica Belgica takes this opportunity to highlight the importance of their contribution to the knowledge of the geology of Wallonia.

3. Schieferstollen underground quarry at Recht (50°19'17"N, 06°03'40"E)
Cross section in the Ordovician, ornamental stone, Ardenne minerals, coticule
Entrance fees: 7 € per person
4. Lasnenville quarry (Boreta company) at Bellevaux-Ligneuville (50°22'40"N, 06°00'54"E)
Deville Group (lower Cambrian), Bellevaux Formation

Due to road works on E40 highway near Alleur, plan to leave in advance if you have to take this part of the highway. There are major slowdowns during the day (not only rush hours). Then take E42 highway (Prüm direction) until exit n° 12.
